Anyone who would like to become a Board Member must firstly be a shareholder. In return for a £1 share for life, all tenants and leaseholders who live on Battersea Park Estate can become members.

A share in the BFRMO entitles you to attend open General Meetings, to vote and be elected to the Board which is responsible for running the organisation.

Dog Fouling

Unfortunately dog fouling on communal areas continues to be an issue on our Estate. We remind dog owners that Battersea Park Estate has dog byelaws in place and owners of dogs who breach the byelaws could face fines of up to £500 and have permission to keep a dog in their property revoked. Bike enclosures

Two brand new bike enclosures have now been installed at the north end of Macdonald House, corner of Dagnall Street. Funding for these enclosures were approved last year through a grant from Wandsworth Council's Small Improvement Budget, meaning there was no charge to tenants or leaseholders to have them installed.

The enclosures are free to bike users on the estate at no charge but is a first come first served basis. Each enclosure is locked by a closed shackle combination lock, if you would like to obtain the code please contact the Estate office where we'll take down a few details including the make and colour of your bike.

Please note that the enclosure is intended for active bike users and so it should not be used for permanent storage of bicycles, we'll be monitoring the use of the enclosure and any bikes that look to be not used or abandoned may be removed. Battersea Fields Resident Organisation takes no responsibility of the security of the enclosure so bike owners are to use it at their own risk. Users should have their own chain and lock which is to be secured to one of the metal hoops inside the enclosure.

If these enclosures are well used then there is scope to have another enclosure elsewhere on the Estate.


Brighton Trip
